And so the 33-year-old billionaire has come up with a simple trick to tackle the tasks he tends to put off. "If you don't want to do something, make a deal with yourself to do at least five minutes of it. After five minutes, you'll end up doing the whole thing". ('Quartz at Work', 8 June 2017).

They knew they needed oil for their lamps but they decide to delay getting the oil: "No worries, can always buy from the nearby shops. Or, worse case, can always borrow oil from the others."
